Refer back to your notes from Pastor Jeff's sermon on Sunday as you work through the following CLG material.



Consider Peter's powerful proclamation in Acts 2:37-38. In what ways does God guarantee that the Holy Spirit will be accessible to everyone? If the Spirit is indeed a gift given to us, what does this say about God's role as giver and our role as receiver?

Digging Deeper: Read Luke 11:5-13. These verses remind us that God does not want us to be passive or timid regarding anything that he gives us, especially the Holy Spirit. In what ways do these verses call us to an active role in receiving what God has for us.



The activity of the Holy Spirit was quite evident in the events surrounding Jesus birth (Luke 1:15; 35; 41; 67; 2:25-27). In what way was the Holy Spirit's activity different on the Day of Pentecost?

Digging Deeper: How does Jesus' statement to his disciples in John 14:17 impact us today? Consider the importance of what Paul declares in 2 Corinthians 13:5 and Ephesians 3:16-17.



By giving us his Spirit, God has made it possible for all of us to help accomplish his purposes in the lives of others who do not yet know him. We serve others with special abilities (spiritual gifts) that come from him. Consider the following verses: Acts 2:11-12; 2:14; 2:17-18. Discuss how these special abilities can in fact help others to know Christ!

Digging Deeper: Ultimately, who should be the first to benefit from the spiritual gifts that God has given us (consider Romans 12:4-8; 1 Peter 4:10-11)? Who is first to lose out if we don't use these gifts? Why does this matter?
